





# CSA's Intent

## ★ Remain the Most Decisive Land Force in the World

- We Must do Better at Leveraging Available Technologies to Give our Soldiers the Advantage...Said Another Way, We Cannot let Technology Disadvantage our Soldiers

## ★ Sustain the High Quality All-Volunteer Army
