



## **Sergeant Major Kevin E. McCrary**

Sgt. Maj. Kevin E. McCrary became the Army Chief Information Officer/G-6 Senior Enlisted Adviser on February 22, 2011. Sgt. Maj McCrary serves as the Army's CIO/G-6's personal adviser on all enlisted matters in areas related to Information Technology affecting operations and Soldier training and quality of life across the Army.

He has held a variety of leadership positions throughout his career from Signal Team Chief, Section Sergeant, Shift Supervisor, Platoon Sergeant, First Sergeant, Drill Sergeant, Senior Drill Sergeant, Equal Opportunity Advisor, Training and Operations Officer to a nominative position as Operations Sergeant Major, White House Communications Agency.

Sgt. Maj. McCrary was born in Knoxville, Tenn., and enlisted in the Army in June, 1985. He attended Basic Combat Training at Fort Jackson, S.C., Advanced Individual Training at the U.S. Army Signal School, Fort Gordon, Ga., and graduated as a 31M Multi-Communications Equipment Operator.

During his tour at the White House he served as a Special Missions Operations Officer, First Sergeant of 2<sup>nd</sup> Presidential Communications Command, and Senior Enlisted Adviser for Vice Presidential Communications Officers, as well as Operations Sergeant Major.

Sgt. Maj. McCrary's military education includes all levels of the Noncommissioned Officer Education System. He is a graduate of the Army Drill Sergeant School, Master Fitness Trainer Course, White House Presidential Communications Course, First Sergeants Course and an Honor Graduate of the United States Army Sergeants Major Academy.
