Personally Identifiable Information (PII) for general administrative duties is stored and resides on the NIPRNET LAN. Administrative copies of documents such as of the SF50 and Emergency Essential personnel records are as required for mission and stored on the the NIPRNET and maintained in accordance with the Army's Record Keeping Schedule. The system does not require the PII or the Forms, but does provide a location for electronic record management as required by AR 25-1.

(2) Briefly describe the privacy risks associated with the PII collected and how these risks are addressed to safeguard privacy.

SF50 and EE personnel records contains individual's name, SSN, and birthday information. The electronic records are stored in the share drive with security permission that can be accessed by authorized staff.

- All access is logged and available for audit.
- Access to PII on network is permissions based on a need to know for official use only.
- Network security devices such as firewalls, intrusion detection systems and system logging are all used in a tiered defense infrastructure.
- Access to network is controlled through Common Access Cards (CAC) with PKI encryption.
- Users have completed information assurance training and reviewed network user license agreements, and signed Acceptable User Policy memorandums.
