## Dr. Bryan M. Shone, PhD

*Director, Policy and Resources and Chief Financial Officer*



Dr. Bryan M. Shone became the Director for Policy and Resources and the Chief Financial Officer at the Headquarters, Department of the Army, Chief Information Officer (CIO)/G-6 on April 1, 2019.

As the Director and Chief Financial Officer, Dr. Shone reports directly to the Army CIO/G-6. He is responsible for providing vision, direction, and technical advice to the CIO/G-6 with a focus on all matters relating to planning, programming, and budgeting for Information Technology (IT) and Command, Control, Communications, and Computers (C4) programs. He oversees the Army's IT appropriations, totaling more than \$10 billion, as well as efforts that drive IT management reform, including enterprise licensing, Army IT policy, business case analyses, implementation of enterprise services, and IT investment management. He also directs the Army's IT professional career development program for more than 11,000 Army civilians.

Dr. Shone's experience covers the breadth of DoD's planning, programming, budgeting, and execution system. He has analyzed, developed, and integrated programmatic plans across the Future Years Defense Program (FYDP) to improve the alignment of both funding and manpower in support of strategic defense priorities.

Prior to his current assignment, he served as the lead Operations Research Analyst for cyberspace activities in the C4 and Information Programs Division, Office of Cost Assessment and Program Evaluation (CAPE), Office of the Secretary of Defense (OSD), where he was responsible for leading all activities for the Cyber Issue Team during Program and Budget Review, conducting analyses to inform resourcing decisions across the cyber domain, leading Strategic Portfolio Reviews and Front End Assessments, and supporting the development of and resource alignment to the DoD Cyber Strategy. Prior to that assignment, he served as the Senior Special Assistant to the Director of CAPE, OSD.

Dr. Shone also served as an Operations Research Analyst for the Economic and Manpower Analysis Division, CAPE, OSD, where he co-led the Manpower and Medical Issue Teams, developing resourcing options and leading analytic efforts to reallocate manpower and improve the Defense Health Program.

Dr. Shone has a Bachelor of Arts in Economics from Salisbury University, a Master of Arts in Economics from the University of Tennessee, and a PhD in Economics from the University of Tennessee. His accomplishments as a federal civilian have been recognized with the Office of the Secretary of Defense Award for Excellence (3 awards), the Office of the Secretary of Defense Medal for Exceptional Civilian Service, and the Cost Assessment and Program Evaluation Certificate of Superior Accomplishment.

Dr. Shone lives in Alexandria, Virginia, with his wife, Sara, and their son, Andrew.
